

The "AQUA30"

Aqua30's use the same robust ridged plastic container as those used for the Standard Aquaboxes. Each box has a capacity of roughly 75 litres and this volume is used to hold 30 sets of Filter and Purification Tablets.

Every **Aqua30** is capable of generating 33,000 litres of drinking water from the local contaminated water sources. Enough drinking water for over 150 people for 110 days; or 33 tonnes of drinking water.

- **Aqua30's** only contain filters and do not contain the ancillary survival bags or the humanitarian aid items of the **Standard Aquabox**.
- **Aqua30's** are not sent out for filling, but are available for sponsorship via donations. (See the **Order Form**)
- **Aqua30's** are produced and despatched to areas of dire need and where their distribution can be well monitored by the distributing aid agencies.
- **Aqua30's** are often sent out to supplement each batch of **10 Standard Aquaboxes** in the field, and doing so will extend the drinking water life of the Standard box to over a year.

Aqua30's are also especially useful in meeting the drinking water needs of the hospitals and schools in the disaster struck areas.
